BE PROFESSIONAL & INTENTIONAL

Dress professionally and be respectful to all persons you interact with in the Zoom room. First impressions count!

CAMERA AND AUDIO ETTIQUETTE

Keep your camera on throughout the interview and the Admissions Interview Day program. Keep your audio muted unless speaking to reduce disruptions.

PRACTICE MAKES PROGRESS

Research the program and be prepared to discuss why you want to attend UIWRSO. Participate in mock interviews to help feel more confident discussing your interest in the optometric profession and your future career goals.

A POSITIVE START AND FINISH

Be ready to introduce yourself in 3 minutes or less. Highlight the primary undergraduate/graduate institution attended, major and why you are interested in Optometry. Have a few questions prepared to ask your interviewer at the end.

5

RELAX AND BE YOURSELF

You have been chosen to interview for your academic record and stellar qualifications. Be confident and kind. You deserve to be here and now is your chance to shine.
